You learn very valuable things that companies really need now and in the future:

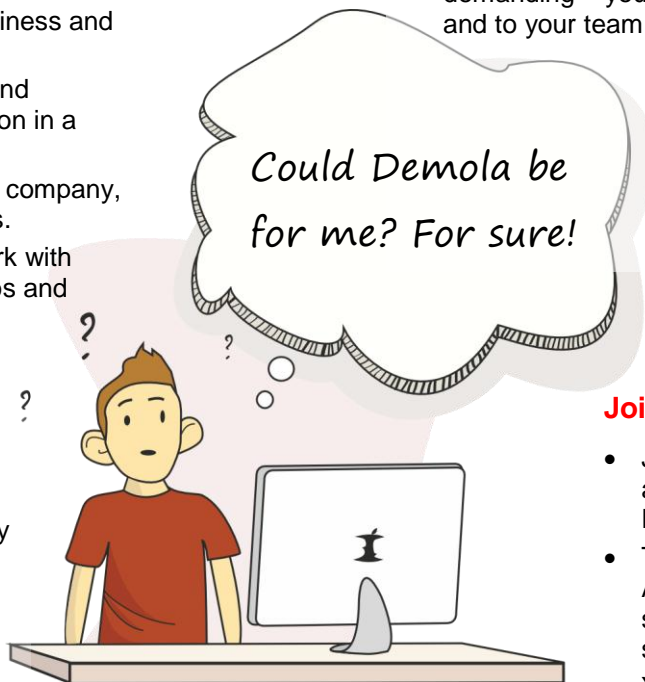
- Building a demo of a product or service concept.

- You can also make videos to spread the word in the social media of what you can do.
